


Color an Otter!

In 1607, George Percy described the animals that he and other settlers saw at Jamestown. He wrote that "there are bears, foxes, otters, beavers, musk cats, and wild beasts unknown." North American river otters were sometimes eaten and their furs were very valuable for trade. These animals almost went extinct in the early 1900's but thanks to conservation efforts they can still be spotted around Jamestown Island today!
