


## **Color the Seeds!**

Pumpkins and other squash were very important local foods for Virginia Indians and the colonists in James Fort. These pumpkin/squash seeds in the shape of a pumpkin, along with about 600 more, were found with other trash in the Second Well. The squash were likely eaten and thrown away around 1612!
