


Color the Tower!

The brick church tower is the only 17th-century building that still stands today at Jamestown. Archaeologists excavating in the tower found the foundations of an earlier church where the first General Assembly met in 1619. Today, you can walk through the tower and Memorial Church and see through the glass floor the remnants of this early church underneath your feet!
