


Color an Ear Picker!

A Jamestown colonist used this beautiful dolphin to scrape plaque from their teeth, clean dirt from their fingernails, and scoop out earwax. This ear picker was made of silver and was very expensive. A gentleman might have owned it and shown it off by wearing it around their neck or on their belt. Surgeons and barbers also often kept ear pickers in their medical kits. (In the 17th century, barbers did many of the same things surgeons did.)
