MULTIPLE LOCATIONS

Next, jump on to the fully-paved Virginia Capital Trail and bike down to the Jamestown Trailhead. Experience a diverse range of scenic views consisting of rich farmlands, wetlands, forests full of wildlife, and majestic views of the James River. For those who may want to modify or add to their route, Jamestown's Island Loop Drive, a three- and five-mile paved path around historic Jamestown Island, is the perfect addition.
